The course is designed for those who work in the educational sector, be it in schools or other institutions, who are interested in dealing with subjects related to intercultural pedagogics.

Lecturers with a broad scientific, practical and research background will be discussing and researching the following areas with you:

- Intercultural and anti-racism education
- Language training
- International social work with children and adolescents
- Migration, multicultural societies and globalisation
- Mechanisms of inclusion and exclusion



In addition you will receive an introduction to the application of new media. The programme combines theory, practical training and empirical research to cover the whole range of intercultural pedagogics.



We offer courses with small numbers of participants (max. 30 students), individual supervision and group tutorials.

Our master programme has been offered successfully since 1999 and has been completed by students from more than 40 different countries.
